Each set of benchmarks is divided by grade level. You'll notice the goal for students followed by a letter and number code. That code designates which Wisconsin Model Academic Performance Standard is linked with the benchmark. Grades 9-10

1. All students will demonstrate the rules of the road. (HRT 1, SCANS Basic Skills A)
2. All students will express an understanding of how alcohol and other drugs affect the ability to drive safely. (HE-A 12.5 HE-B 12.3)
3. All students will demonstrate the natural laws affecting the driving task. (SCANS Basic Skills C)
4. All students will express an understanding of the basic parts of a vehicle and the purpose of those parts. (SCANS Basic Skills C)
5. All students will demonstrate procedures involved in simple car maintenance such as the use of an auto jack. (HRT 1)
6. All students will demonstrate the skills required to pass the required road test. (SCANS Personal Qualities E, HE-A 12.3)
7. All students will demonstrate the skills associated with defensive driving. (HRT 3,6,7 SCANS Personal Qualities E, HE-C 12.3)
8. All students will express an understanding of accountability and consequences in regard to keeping scheduled lessons and driving in general. (HRT 1,7, HE-C 12.3)
9. Students will express an understanding of the responsibilities associated with driving a vehicle in a proper manner. (HRT 1,7, HE-B 12.3, SCANS Personal Qualities E)
